Krušovice Pilsner ...\$5.50

Brewed following a recipe from 1517, and using superior Czech pilsner malt, natural spring water from the K ivoklát Woods and classic Saaz hops. Served in an official half liter Krusovice glass.
5.0% abv.

Pauwel Kwak ...\$7.00

This Belgian strong pale ale is a great alternative to the U.S. microbrews found on tap here. Pouring a cloudy light brown, it features a sweet bready yeast taste with notes of banana and spice. The finish has an alcohol warmth with a slight hop bitterness. Served in an official 18 ounce Pauwel Kwak miniature yardstick glass. 8.4% abv.

Harpoon IPA...\$5.75

Brewed in Boston, Massachusetts this IPA is on the lighter side. Pouring a clear copper, it features a floral hop smell that finishes with a bitter maltiness. Served in a pint glass. 5.9% abv.

Southern Tier Unearthly ...\$6.50

Southern Tier, brewed in Lakewood, New York is known for their aggressive beers. Their high gravity series features the flagship imperial IPA, Unearthly. It features a floral nose along with a citrus. The bold taste found in regular unearthly is subdued by the oak flavor. The finish has a slight caramel bite.
Served in an official 13 oz. Southern Tier Brewery fluted glass. 11.0% abv.

Bear Republic Heritage ...\$6.50

Brewed in Healdsburg, California this Scottish wee heavy ale has never been bottled, and rarely seen in this area. Pouring a reddish amber, it features hints of cherry and figs with a malty sweetness of honey. The malt follows through on the finish with a slight hop bitterness. Grab a glass of this limited treat!
Served in a pint glass. 8.1% abv.

Green Flash Hophead Red ...\$6.50

Brewed in Vista, California this American Amber/Red style beer pours a hazy copper. It features hints of sweet caramel and brown sugar with notes of pine and citrus. The finish brings a lingering hop bitterness. Served in a pint glass. 6.4% abv.

Breckenridge Vanilla Porter ...\$5.25

Brewed in Colorado, this American porter is a great way to warm up on a cold winter night. Pouring a dark brown, it features a sweet maltiness that finishes with roasted malts and a noticeable vanilla taste.
Served in a pint glass. 4.7% abv.

Bell's Best Brown Ale...\$5.25

Brewed in Comstock, Michigan this beer is a smooth drink. Pouring a deep amber brown, it features toasted malts with a hint of brown sugar and caramel. The finish is slightly bitter to balance out the sweet upfront taste. Served in a pint glass. 5.8% abv.
